Pearl Winslow, age 95, a longtime resident of Rensselaer passed away on Saturday, December 31, 2016 at Parkview Haven, Francesville, Indiana. Pearl was born in North Dakota on August 28, 1921 to Henry and Nora (Lockridge) Spangler. She moved to Indiana with her family where she graduated with the Class of 1939 from Brook High School.

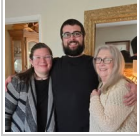
