



## Ralph "Ole" Myers

January 5, 1934 - December 14, 2023

Ralph "Ole" Edward Myers, 89, a cherished resident of Rensselaer, Indiana, peacefully passed away on December 14, 2023, at Autumn Trace. Born on January 5, 1934, in Rensselaer, IN, he was the beloved son of Ralph and Opal (Potts) Myers.

Ole's journey included graduating from Fair Oaks High School with the Class of 1952 and serving dutifully in the United States Army from 1955 to 1958. On September 28, 1957, he united in marriage with Doris Ann Misch in Wheatfield, IN, and her loss in 2022 left a profound void in his life.

Professionally, Ole dedicated 30 years working at Jasper County Co-Op, serving as Department Manager for 20 years. 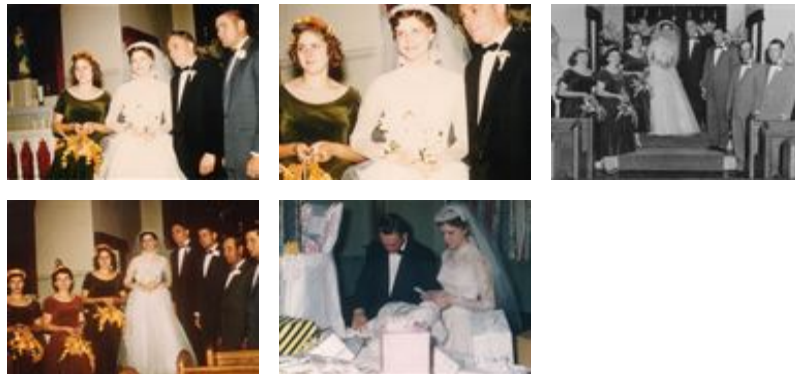
