



## Ramon D. Sayler

February 11, 1927 - August 29, 2016

Ramon D. Sayler, age 89, of Rensselaer, Indiana passed away at his home on August 29, 2016. Ramon was born in Morocco, Indiana on February 11, 1927, the son of Harold Dean and Revia (Reames) Sayler. Ramon moved to Rensselaer with his family in 1928.

Ramon graduated from Rensselaer High School with the Class of 1945. He joined the U.S. Army Air Force, serving in the Philippines until December 1946. Ramon worked as the State Stone Inspector for Jasper and Newton Counties. He was the owner and operator of Sayler Floor Covering from 1962 until his retirement in 2000, learning his trade from John Hudson. Ramon also worked at the former Northway Products and was a substitute mail carrier. On June 7, 1952, in Etna Green, Indiana, Ramon married Betty Lou Haynes who survives.

He was an avid photographer and developer, something he enjoyed doing for many years. Ramon was an excellent drummer and was a member of the former Melody Aces band.

Surviving with his loving wife of 64 years Betty are their children, Denny (Pamela) Sayler of Rensselaer, Cindy (Danny) Smith of Sheridan, Arkansas, Jeff (Julie) Sayler of Wichita, Kansas and Linda (Gary) Kingma of Lafayette, Indiana; twelve grandchildren, Kenton, Ericka, Landon, Michael, Rob, Ryal, Reid, Meghann, Katherine, Ashley, Kyle and Nicole; eight great-grandchildren with two on the way; his sister, Phyllis Hieronymus of Lakeland, Florida and numerous nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews. He was

preceded in death by his parents.
