Richard "Rick" Lee Chambers, born on February 23, 1963, in Brook, Indiana, to Charles and Bonnie (Strain) Chambers, passed away on Monday, August 19, 2024. Rick graduated from Rensselaer Central High School with the class of 1981 and furthered his education at a mechanic school in Ohio. He married Anita Graves on March 19, 1988, in Virgie, Indiana, and was deeply saddened by her passing on January 2, 2000.

Rick worked at the City of Rensselaer Recycling Center for seven years and previously was employed at Tillet Engineering, where he poured concrete. He was an active member of the Rensselaer Moose Post #2272 and the VFW Post #1279. Rick had a passion for fishing, playing cornhole and darts with loved ones, and snowmobiling in the winter.
