Robert Rex Binge age 86, of Boerne, TX, passed away Friday, October 2, 2015 in Texas. Robert was born December 25, 1928, in Thayer, Ind., the son of Rex and Elizabeth E. (Davis) Binge, both deceased. Robert grew up in Newton County graduating from the Mount Ayr High School class of 1948. In November of 1954 Robert married Annabelle Hanley and she preceded him in death in 1981. Robert proudly served in the US Armed Forces for 27 years and with the 4033 Air Force Reserves for 13 years. He had resided in Texas since 1969. Robert was a Methodist and was a member of the VFW Post #6012 in San Antonio, TX.

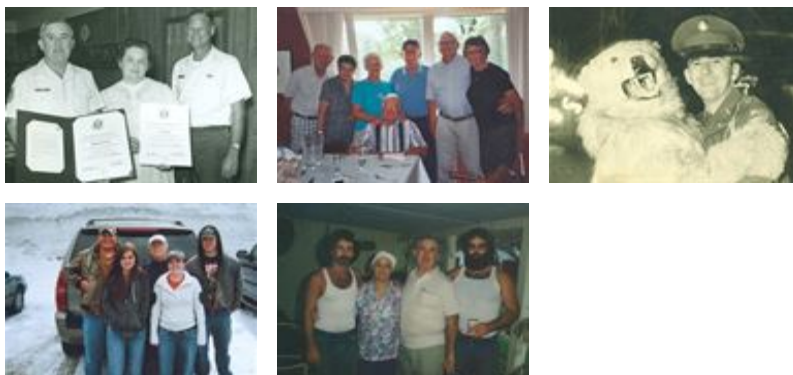
