



Robert "Bob" J. Reichert

May 12, 1959 - January 30, 2016

Mr. Robert (Bob) John Reichert died on January 30, 2016. He was born on May 12, 1959, to Donald H. and Doris L. Reichert in Columbus, Ohio. The Reichert family moved to Rensselaer, Indiana where Robert graduated from Rensselaer Central High School in 1977.

Bob was a loving son, brother, and pet owner. He was employed in the Produce Department at Strack and Van Til in Merrillville, Indiana, and he was an active member of Our Lady of Consolation Catholic Church in Merrillville, Indiana. He served in the Knights of Columbus from 2001 until his death. Bob was a Fourth Degree Knight and served as the Recorder for Good Shepherd Council #10811 of Merrillville for 15 years. He was proud to earn the Knight of the Year Award in 2014. Bob also sang in Our Lady of Consolation's church choir, beginning in 1990.
