Robert W. "Bob" Steinkamp, age 86, of Newburgh, Ind. and a former resident of Rensselaer, passed away at his home June 25, 2013. Bob was born April 4, 1927, in Rensselaer, the son of Harold and Ruth Williams Steinkamp. He was raised in Rensselaer and attended the Rensselaer schools.
