Roger G. Dewey, age 64, of Rensselaer passed away on August 29, 2019 at Palos Community Hospital, Palos Heights, Illinois. Roger was born in Chicopee, Massachusetts on November 12, 1954, the son of Gerald and Barbara (nee Mertka) Dewey.

A resident of Rensselaer for the past 23 years, Roger had also lived in both Dalton and Oak Forest, Illinois.
