Roger A. Warran, age 65, a lifetime resident of Rensselaer passed away at his home Sunday, September 14, 2014. Roger was born in Rensselaer on January 4, 1949, the son of Velma (Burnes) Warran LeDrew and the late Charles Warran. He graduated from Rensselaer High School with the Class of 1968. Roger was a mechanic at WB Automotive in Rensselaer for 22 years. He then went to work as a mechanic and sign-man with the Jasper County Highway Department for 13 years. Roger served with the U. S. Army and was a veteran of the Viet Nam War. He was a member of the Rensselaer American Legion Post #29. Roger was a member and past president of the JC Cruisers and enjoyed refurbishing and cruising in older model cars.

His marriage was in Laughlin, Nevada on July 11, 1996, to Gayla Dunn Warran who survives.

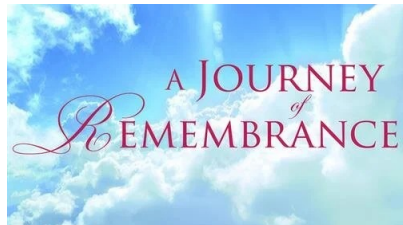

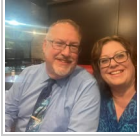
