Ronald D. Canaday, age 68, of Rensselaer, passed away peacefully at Vibra Hospital in Crown Point on Friday, March 9, 2018. Ronald was born on March 2, 1950 in San Francisco, CA, the son of Kenneth & Christa (Bruner) Canaday, both deceased.

Ronald graduated from Morton High School in Hammond, IN, the Class of 1968. On August 8, 1981, in Lake Village, Indiana, he married Sandra Belt, who survives.

Ronald retired from Reiter Industries, Inc. and US Steel where he was employed as a maintenance mechanic for more than 20 years of employment. 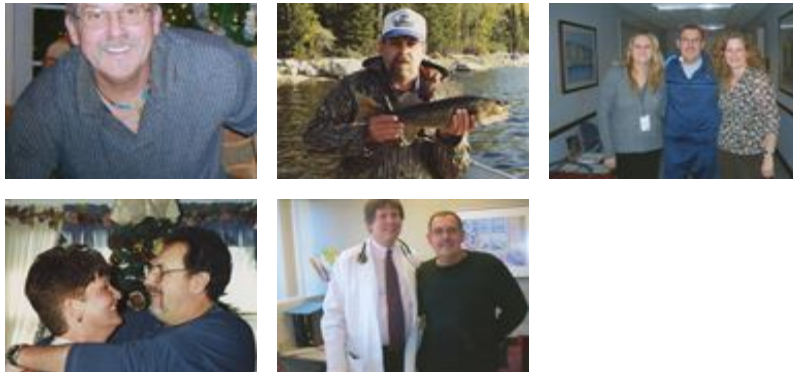
