Rosalene "Rose" Osborn, 83, of Rensselaer, Indiana, passed away at St. Vincent's Hospital in Indianapolis on Friday, June 24, 2022. Rose was born in Prestonsburg, Kentucky on November 29, 1938, to the late Thomas and Rosa (Stephens) Prater. Rose was a resident of Rensselaer for 74 years and Prestonsburg, Kentucky for 9 years.
