Scott Alan Retzlaff, age 56, of DeMotte, Indiana passed away Thursday, December 26, 2019 at the University of Chicago Medical Center, Chicago, Illinois. Scott was born on October 19, 1963 in Harvey, Illinois, the son of Gene and Bettye (Cockrell) Retzlaff.

Scott graduated from Kankakee Valley High School, the Class of 1981. He married the love of his life, Karen Huhn on September 17, 1983 in DeMotte, IN. Scott was the owner and operator of Scott's Auto Body in DeMotte, since 2007. He was a former member of the Lincoln Township and Keener Township Volunteer Fire Departments and was still an active supporter. He was a past DeMotte Little League Girls Softball coach. 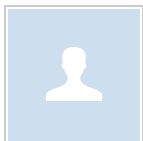

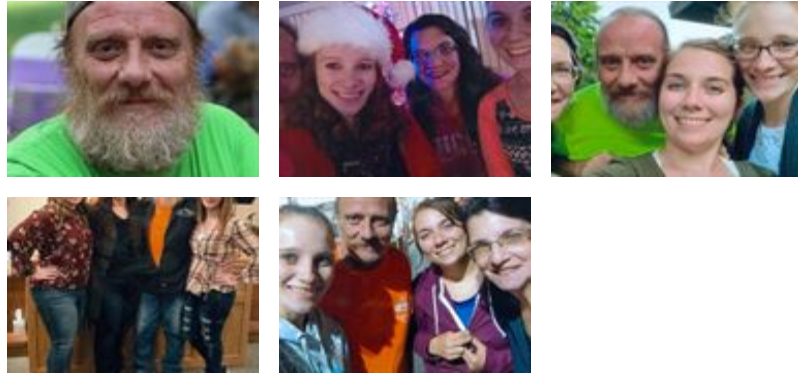
