Sherrie Ann Preston, age 68, of Rensselaer, Indiana passed away unexpectedly March 5, 2018 at Franciscan Health in Lafayette, Indiana. 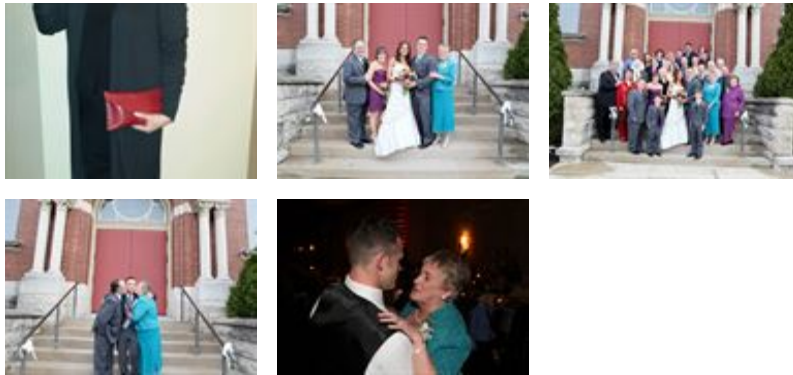
