Stella A. Ramey, age 84, of Rensselaer passed away Saturday July 25, 2009 at the Jasper County Hospital. She was born March 6, 1925 in Flemingsburg, Kentucky, the daughter of the late Lula (Payne) and Edgar Calvin List. A resident of the Rensselaer area since 1948, she also lived in Monon, Indiana and near Gibson City, IL. Her marriage to William F. Ramey, with whom she recently celebrated 60 years of marriage, was on August 1, 1948 in Rensselaer, Indiana.

Stella attended the Hanging Grove Township grade school and graduated from Monon High School in 1943. Primarily a homemaker, she worked for Dr. McClure in Monon, Indiana and in the AAA office in Rensselaer as a receptionist and bookkeeper.
