Sue Brusnahan of Greensboro passed away on June 23, 2023. She will be remembered as a devoted wife, mom, (great)grandma, teacher, and friend to many.

Sue was preceded in death by her husband of 59 years, Tom Brusnahan. She is survived by her 5 children, Phil, Marty (Allie), Linda (Chris), Becky and Mary (Markku), by her 9 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren, her sister Ann, and many nieces and nephews. Sue's twin brother Bill died one week after she did, on June 30, 2023.

Born and raised in Ohio, Sue moved to Indiana after her marriage to Tom. They raised their children there, after which they moved to Greensboro, where they lived happily for the next 30+ years.

Sue's career as a university librarian began at St. Joseph's College in Indiana and continued at Jackson Library at the University of North Carolina Greensboro (UNCG), where she served until her retirement. Her greatest joy came from helping students.

Besides her library job, Sue was active in volunteering, including social work with migrant farmers, acting as scout leader, being heavily involved in the Catholic Church, and volunteering at the Greensboro Science Center for

many years.

A graveside service will be conducted, with interment of ashes to follow, on August 2, 2023 at 11:00 a.m. at Mt. Calvary Cemetery in Rensselaer, Indiana.
