Terry E. Rogers, age 75, formerly of Rensselaer, passed away on Friday, February 12, 2021 at IU Health Arnett in Lafayette. Terry was born in Wabash, IN on September 14, 1945, to the late Russell and Naomi (Eckerley) Rogers. He was a resident of the Jasper County area from 1968 till moving to Lafayette, IN in 2014.

On April 6, 1968 in Roann, IN., he married the love of his life, Susan "Sue" K. Hagg.

Terry graduated from North Field High School, Class of 1963. He went on to earn bachelor degrees from Huntington University and Purdue University. For nine years he taught biology at Rensselaer Central High School. He was an insurance agent at Farm Bureau Insurance for 35 years.

Terry was a member of the Burr Oak Community Church of Rensselaer and Junior Achievement of Northern Indiana.

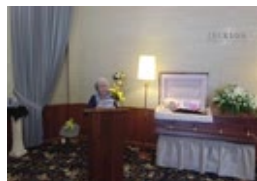

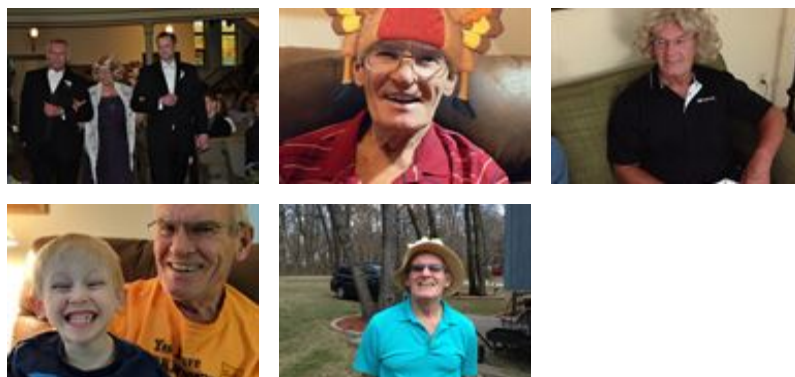
