Thomas C. "Tom" Barrett, age 80, of Rensselaer, Indiana passed away Saturday, September 29, 2018 at his residence. Tom was born on March 4, 1938, the son of Fred and Mable (Daily) Barrett, both deceased.

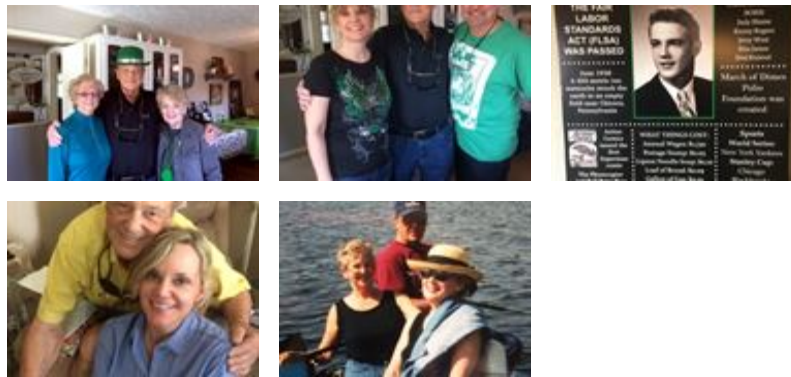
