



## Thomas Calvin "Jukebox" Breyts

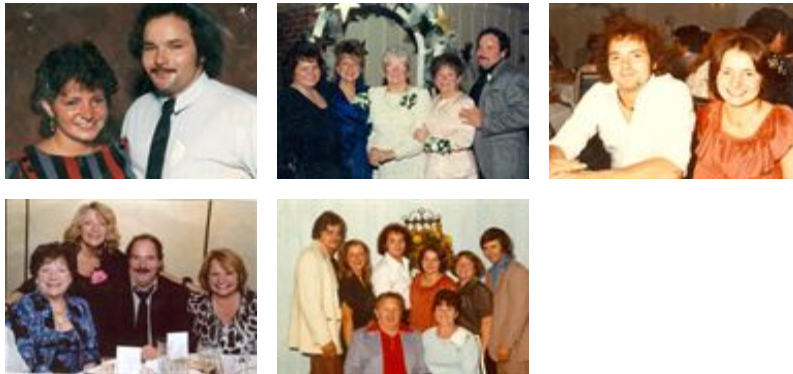

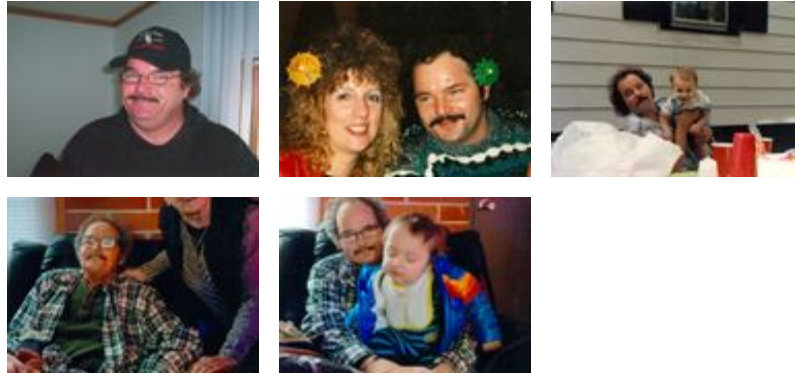
