Walter L. Alexander, age 62, of Mt. Ayr, Indiana passed away on December 4, 2016 at Franciscan Health Rensselaer. 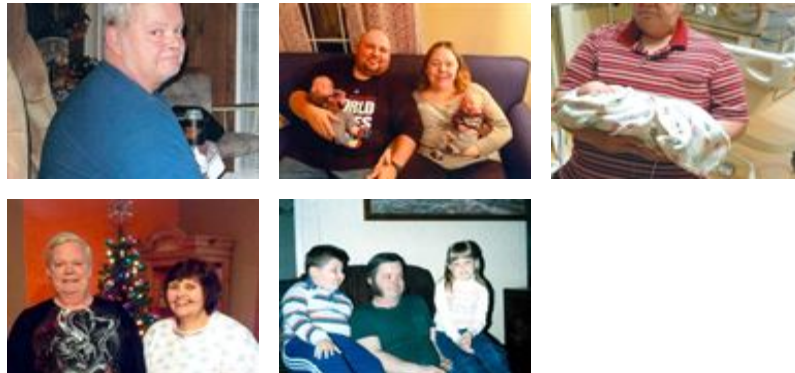
