Wayne Boss, 83, of Wheatfield, Indiana, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 28, 2025, in Hobart, Indiana, surrounded by loved ones.

Wayne was born on July 5, 1942, in East Chicago, Indiana, to Jacob and Charlotte (Beinewicz) Boss. A 1960 graduate of Bloom High School, Wayne proudly served his country in the United States Air Force. 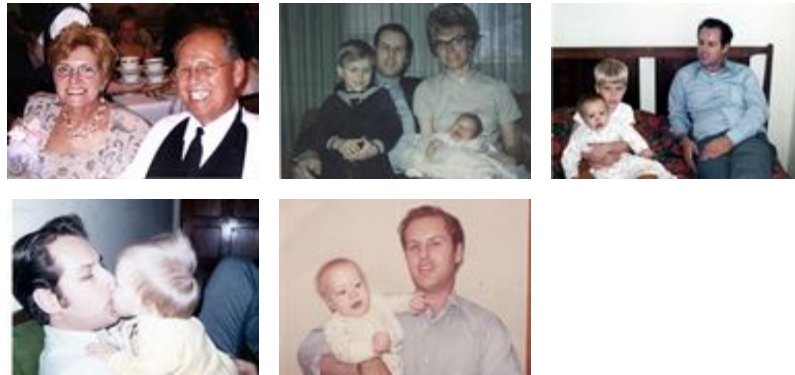

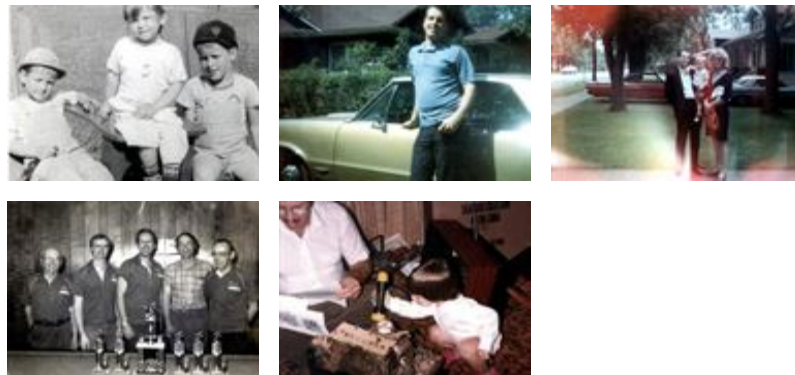

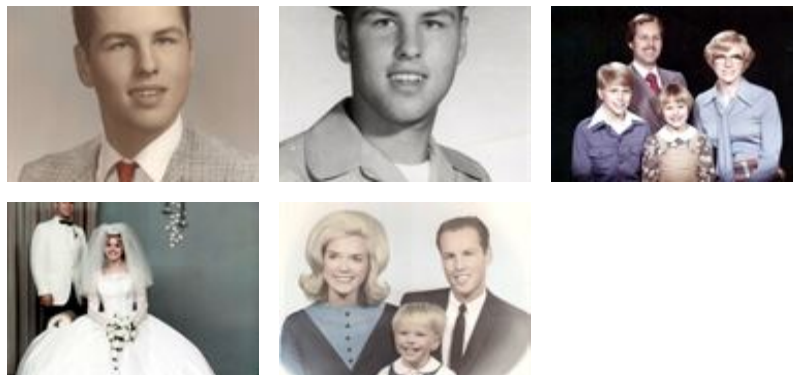
