William E. "Bill" Haworth, Sr., age 83, passed away May 1, 2010 at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis. He was born June 9, 1926 in Burlington, Iowa, the son of the late William F. and Clara A.(Jagels) Haworth. Bill lived in Gary for 10 years, moved to Rensselaer in 1971 and to Greenwood in February, 2010.

Bill was a 1946 graduate of Warsaw (IL) High School. He received his Bachelor's degree from the University of Tulsa and Master's degree from the University of Illinois. A school psychologist, Bill worked in the Gary school system for 10 years and retired from the Rensselaer Central School Corporation after 21 years of employment. He was a member of the Saint Augustine Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus in Rensselaer. Bill was in the European Theatre during World War II while serving in the U.S. Navy.

His marriage was in Ft. Madison, Iowa on May 30, 1952 to Elizabeth "Betty" Koellner who passed away August 14, 1991.

Bill is survived by four children, William E. (Karen) Haworth, Northbrook, IL, Gregory R. (Mary Burgwinkle) Haworth, Plainfield, NJ, Dennis M. (Amy) Haworth, Carmel, IN and Barbara (Eric) Hoch, Greenwood, IN; five grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and one sister, Barbara (Richard) Olejnik, Demotte, IN. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, one

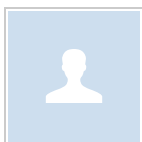

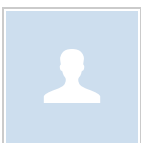
